Session 1 June 12 - June 30

R06 *New* Read, Lead, Succeed! - 8:00 am - 10:00 am

As a class, we will be working through a novel of choice together. Students will be given a choice between four to five novels to unanimously choose from. Working through the novel together, we will be able to cover different strategies to overcome difficult vocabulary, comprehension strategies, etc. At the end of the course, with parent permission, we will watch the movie that was based off of that book. This will give us the opportunity to compare/contrast the events in the book and how they were portrayed through the film as well as the impact these changes had.

A08 *New* Glee Club - 8:00 am - 10:00 am

We will work on singing solos, duets, and large group pieces. Each week our group will be assigned a theme and students will be required to find a song that fits that theme and prepare it for the class. Every Friday will be our performance day. At the end of the 3 weeks, we will have a recital where each student will have a solo or duet that they will perform for their friends and family. In addition, we will also prepare a large group piece that will end the recital. Any students who enjoy singing will have a fun experience working on these pieces! :)

D08 Babysitter Training - 8:00 am - 10:00 am

Staying home alone or babysitting this summer? In this class, we will explore how to be safe and responsible when adults are not home.

#S08 *New* Fun in the Maker Lab! 01 - 8:00 am - 10:00 am

Get introduced to STEM [Science, Technology, Engineering, Math] concepts using the OMS Makerlab materials, including robots, littleBits, Makey Makey, and Lego Mindstorms. Students will learn how to program with Scratch, use stop animation and green screen technologies, and invent new things using tech & everyday materials!

If you enjoy challenge then this class is for you.

T03 *New* Photography: Life through the lens 10:00 am-12:00 pm

As a class, we will inspire and motivate each other to grow our passion for reading. The class will be set up in a book club format with a variety of titles and genres available for students to choose from. Students will be given a focus question or skill that we first work through as a class. Then, students will be set off into their reading groups to work through these skills and discuss the text on a deeper level with one another (as well as with guidance from me). There will be time for independent reading as well as read alouds in small groups.

A18 Summer Musical - 10:00 am - 12:00 pm

A class for all musical performer wannabe's! This class will teach you how to audition, practice, and perform in a musical. You will act, sing, create the set, and perform for an audience. Everyone will have a part in the musical. This will be a fun learning experience, and we will show off our skills with a performance for family and friends at the end! This year we will be performing: **Abacadabra Aladdin!**
