

Additional Scholarships 2024

The following scholarships all use their own forms. You must use their forms. The forms are available in one of two ways:

- 1) **In MHS College and Career Center Office.** Give Mrs. Feit or Mrs. Morris a list of what you would like and they will be happy to assist you with the needed applications.
- 2) **Online.** Some scholarship applications in this section are available on-line only. Read the scholarship descriptions carefully.

Completed applications may be returned to Mrs. Feit or Mrs. Morris in the MHS College and Career Office, if not required to submit on-line. They will provide transcripts for you if it is a requirement of the application. **DO NOT** use Parchment to request transcripts for scholarships. We will provide them for you free of charge. Note that the MHS College and Career Center office will be **closed** over spring break – March 25-29. Make advance arrangements if you need transcripts or applications for scholarships that are due during this time frame.

Tech & 4 Yr. Gordon Olson Memorial Scholarship sponsored by the Deena Hatch Foundation: One \$5,000 award for a Mauston senior. There is no minimum GPA required. The applicant should be pursuing one of the following three fields: education, finance, or business administration. A professional essay is required. Further information may be obtained from Mrs. Mead or Mrs. Feit. Due by Thursday, April 4.

Tech & 4 Yr. George Braund Memorial Scholarship sponsored by the Deena Hatch Foundation: One \$5,000 award for a Mauston senior. There is no minimum GPA required. **Applicant must have finished all four years of high school in good standing, NO Co-Curricular Code violations.** The applicant should be going into any field that is kid centered and people related. A professional essay is required that includes specific contacts with his family or those who knew Mr. Braund. Further information may be obtained from Mrs. Mead or Mrs. Feit. Due by Thursday, April 4.

Tech & 4 Yr. Judge Thomas J. Curran Memorial Scholarship sponsored by the Deena Hatch Foundation: One \$5,000 award for a Mauston senior. Candidates must have resided in the Mauston School District for at least two consecutive years prior to applying. Special consideration shall be given to extra-curricular activities, with a particular emphasis on music and forensics participation. Academic achievement including grades, class rank, and standardized test scores will be considered. A professional essay is required that includes specific contacts with his family or those who knew Judge Curran. Further information may be obtained from Judge Curran family members, Mrs. Mead or Mrs. Feit. Due by Thursday, April 4.

Tech & 4 Yr. William H. Hatch Memorial Scholarship sponsored by the Deena Hatch Foundation: Two \$5,000 awards for Mauston seniors. The application process includes completion of a specific application form, a professional essay written about the life of William Hatch and how he has had a positive impact on our community, and an interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee: Further information may be obtained from Mrs. Mead or Mrs. Feit. Due by Thursday, April 4.

Tech & 4 Yr. Russell Dillin Memorial Scholarship: Russell Dillin made an impact in the lives of many people. He believed in his faith, celebrating others talents, treating people with respect and had a love of the outdoors. Provide examples of how he has made an impact on you and how you will demonstrate those values in the future. (Maximum one page essay) Due by Thursday, April 4.

Tech & 4 Yr. Leer Inc.-Chuck Nicksic Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000 for a Mauston High School senior. You do **NOT** need to have a parent/step parent employed by Leer, Inc. for this memorial. Due by April 1. Applications may be obtained from the MHS College and Career Center.

Tech & 4 Yr. Leer Inc Three \$2,500 scholarships to be awarded to seniors who have a parent/step parent employed by Leer, Inc. for at least six months prior to the April 1 deadline of the scholarship. Due by April 1. Applications may be obtained from the MHS College and Career Center.

4 Yr. Jan Ray Scholarship: – Several \$1,500 scholarships for seniors who are residents of Juneau, Adams or Monroe County. Applicants must have a cumulative 2.0 GPA or higher and planning to major in a social services field with priority given to those with social work majors. Examples of appropriate majors are: counseling, human services, psychology, and social workers. Apply by March 15. Applications may be obtained from the MHS College and Career Center.

Tech & 4 Yr. Alex Coggins & Russell Dillin Memorial Scholarship: Two \$1,000 scholarships for seniors planning to enter a **mental health or healthcare field.** Priority will be given to those with exceptional school and community involvement. ****Tech & 4 Yr. Hess Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship:** Six \$2,500 scholarships to seniors furthering their education in a **medical field.** Applications may be obtained from the MHS College and Career Center. Apply by March 31.

****4 YR – UW System:** UW HELP Emma D. Boettiger Scholarship: Two \$2,000 awards to seniors furthering their education at a UW System College in a health related field. ****Tech & 4 Yr. W.I.L.D.Scholarship:** One \$1,000 from the Community Foundation of Southern Wisconsin: for seniors in area counties, including Juneau. Must have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA. Preference for financial need but it is not a restriction of applying. Their essay has to do with the Wilderness Resort in Wis. Dells. Applications may be obtained from the MHS College and Career Center or on line at: cfsw.org Apply no later than March 1.

Tech & 4 Yr. MHS Student Council Scholarship: for seniors who are active members of the MHS Student Council. Applications are available in the MHS College and Career Center. – Due Thursday April 4.

Tech & 4 Yr. Mauston Youth Soccer Club Scholarship: Up to \$500 for seniors who were a **participant of the Mauston Area Youth Soccer Program.** Award amounts may vary depending on the applicant pool and the qualifications of the applicants. Tech & 4 Yr. Golden Eagle Athletic Booster Club Scholarship: Two \$1,000 scholarships for MHS seniors with at least a 3.0 cum. GPA. Scholarship form must include a 300 word essay on how your “Golden Eagle experience” helped shape your goals for the next phase of your life. 4 Yr. Only-Mauston Education Association (MEA) Scholarship: One or more scholarships for Teaching / Education must be a part of their major. Preference will be given to applicants who have participated in the Educator's Rising Club or Education CAPP course. You must use the scholarship application provided by the Mauston Education Association. Pick up in the MHS College and Career Center.. Apply by April 15.

4 Yr. Only-Educator Rising Scholarship: \$500-\$2000 scholarship range for prospective future educators who are members of the Educator Rising program at MHS. Apply between January 2 and April 1 on-line at www.educatorsrising.org

4 Yr. Only - South Central Shamrock Club—One or more \$1,000 scholarship to a senior from Baraboo, Reedsburg, Mauston, Weston or Wisconsin Dells High Schools pursuing **a teaching degree in special needs education.** Pick up applications in the MHS College and Career Center. Due by April 15.

4 Yr.
