Hello EASP Families,

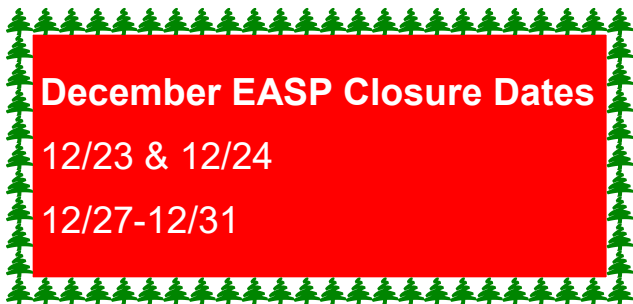
