 <b>Tech &amp; Speciality:</b> <u>Tay Mac Memorial Scholarship:</u> One or two \$2,500 scholarships for MHS seniors pursing a degree in cosmetology.
 <b>4 Yr.</b> McFarlane/Cure Scholarship: Five to ten - \$2,000 scholarships for MHS seniors. In addition to a high grade point average and ACT score, particular consideration and weight is given to the rigor of the student's academic record in high school (Advanced placement and other upper level courses).
 <b>Tech &amp; 4 Yr.</b> Mauston Area Ambulance Association Scholarship: Two \$500 scholarships for MHS seniors planning to major in a medical field at a technical college or four- year university.
 <b>Tech &amp; 4 Yr.</b> <u>Mile Bluff Medical Center Scholarship:</u> One \$500 scholarship for MHS seniors planning to attend a four-year university or technical college in a medical field.
<b>Tech &amp; 4 Yr.</b> Northside Mobil/Exxon Scholarship: Two \$250 Scholarships for a MHS senior who is planning to further their education in science, mathematics or a STEM related field of study.

 Tech & 4 Yr. Courtney Fischer Memorial Scholarship: One \$200 scholarships for MHS seniors.
 Tech & 4 Yr. VFW-McEvoy Miller Post #2114: Two \$1,000 scholarships for a MHS seniors.
 Tech & 4 Yr. Camp Douglas Masonic Lodge: One \$500 scholarship for a MHS senior.
 <b>Tech &amp; 4 Yr.</b> Crowley Family Scholarship: One \$500 scholarship for a MHS senior who demonstrates a strong work ethic and values the importance of receiving a good education.
 <b>Tech &amp; 4 Yr.</b> <u>Howard and Charlotte Ganther Memorial Scholarship:</u> Four scholarships for MHS seniors. Recipients of this scholarship tend to be average, hard working students-not at the top-end. Memorial is set up to benefit students with B or C Grade standing vs. giving scholarships to the top 5% of the class.

 <b>Tech &amp; 4 Yr.</b> Art & Jean Baldwin Memorial Scholarship: One \$2,000 or two \$1,000 scholarships for MHS seniors who are active members of either the MHS choir or band program. #1 priority will be awarded to a senior planning to major or minor in music OR #2 priority will award to a senior planning to attend technical college for an auto mechanic program. Awards will depend on the applicant pool with the Class of 2023.
 <b>Tech &amp; 4 Yr.</b> <u>Dells Kiwanis Club Scholarship:</u> Two \$500 scholarships for MHS seniors who are a current <b>Mauston Key Club</b> member and have completed over 50 Key Club services hours.

	Tech & 4 Yr. Kids and Mentors Outdoors (KAMO) Scholarship: One \$500 scholarship for a Mauston, New Lisbon, Necedah or Tomah senior planning to attend a to enroll into the field of <i>Natural Resources</i> .
	4 Yr. <u>Dallas Enz Memorial Scholarship:</u> One \$500 scholarship to a MHS senior. Preference may be given to students who have been involved in the Mauston band program and/or the Mauston football program.

	<b>4 Yr.</b> Mauston Wrestling Club Scholarship: Two or more \$500 scholarships will be awarded for MHS seniors who have been members of the Mauston Wrestling Team (as a wrestler or statistician).
	Tech & 4 Yr. <u>Tuna Frisch Memorial Scholarship:</u> One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded for MHS seniors who have been members of the Mauston Wrestling Team (as a wrestler or statistician). This scholarship is sponsored by the 3 <sup>rd</sup> District Taverr League.
	4 Yr. Gerard Brunner Memorial Scholarship: \$8,000 scholarship for a senior pursuing a degree in a field of manufacturing or mechanical engineering. (not computer or health engineering fields)
