The School District of Mauston Board of Education unanimously approved a \$54.8 million referendum question for the November 3 ballot. The District considered pausing facilities planning in light of the current situation, but the educational and maintenance needs remain. We believe it's a good time to move forward with improvements that will benefit our students and the community for decades to come. The referendum plan is for:



Beginning in the 2021-22 school year, the debt portion of the school property tax bill will drop. The reduction in the loan payment allows the community to make a significant investment in Mauston schools with a minimal tax impact.


