Referendum Project and Campus Field Work

Over the next several months the District will be planning for construction work to take place on several of our school buildings and grounds beginning June 2016 through late fall 2016. Here is a quick summary:

- Roof replacements at Grayside and West Side Schools in Summer 2016 (paid for by referendum)
- HVAC system replacement at OMS in Summer 2016 (paid for by General Fund)
- Bathroom upgrades at OMS in Summer 2016 (paid for by referendum)
- Track and Field upgrades, bleacher and lighting replacement in late October, November 2016 (paid for by referendum)

The Property and Transportation Committee serves as the oversight for all referendum improvement projects. A second committee called Campus Fields Advisory Team has been approved by the Board of Education to plan for a comprehensive and expansive plan for the other fields and grounds on our primary campus in the District.

Campus Fields Advisory Team will work toward a larger master plan (not funded by referendum) to improve the District's community athletic/activity fields and grounds that lie just south of our school buildings. Campus Fields will provide opportunities over the next several months for parents and citizens to give feedback and input about all track and field improvement work. Plans for community members to have opportunities for information and feedback include the following:

- Monday November 16 District Office Training Room @ 6:00 PM
