

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING  
School District of Mauston**

1. Board President Jim Cauley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll call was taken; all members were present.
2. Mr. Cauley led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. There were no public comments.
3. Mauston High School FFA officers Kadi Walsh and Austin Remington reported for the Mauston chapter. Recent activities included student service projects, and participation in a leadership workshop. Initial membership includes 101 members have signed up and paid dues to date.
4. Mauston teachers Peg Barton and Chris LaVold presented the September Showcase Report, highlighting the district-wide staff work toward becoming a district of Professional Learning Communities. The focus is on student learning, through collaboration, and emphasizing common core standards, common assessments and interventions. The school principals reported on the PLC work in each buildings.
5. Superintendent of Schools Dr. Christine Weymouth reported that Grayside Elementary School has been named a Wisconsin School of Recognition for the 2012-2013 school year. Staff members will attend a ceremony in Madison on October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Dr. Weymouth also reported on district activities including superintendent visits to the school buildings and WEA Trust health screenings offered to covered employees.
6. Motion by Buss/McIntire to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried 7/0.

**Pending Action:**

7. Motion by Rogers/ Kryka to approve the administrative recommendation to hire Greg LaBansky as a social studies teacher at Mauston High School (.8 FTE contract). Following discussion, the motion carried 7/0.
8. Motion by Rogers/Buss to adjust the teaching contract for Mauston High School Teacher Judy Cummings from .8 FTE to 1.0 FTE. Following discussion, the motion carried 7/0.

9. Motion by Rogers/Buss to waive the third reading of Policy 887.1 – Native American Parent/Legal Custodian Advisory Committee, and approve the policy as presented. Motion carried 7/0.
10. Motion by Buss/Zilisch to approve the 2012-2013 School Board Meeting Calendar, including the Date and Time for the 2013 Annual School District Meeting. Motion carried 7/0.
11. Motion by Zilisch/Buss to adjourn to Executive (Closed) Session, pursuant to Wis. Statutes 19.85 (1)(f) “Considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons ... which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data,…” and (c) “...Considering employment, promotion, compensation or evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility;” [Review of Petition for Reconsideration of Early Re-Entry Expulsion Conditions and Discussion Regarding Superintendent Goals for 2012-2013]. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion carried 7/0.
